	<p>21-23 of November 2024, Rome (Italy)</p> <p>The international meeting "Romaní European Historical Memory" took place from November 21th to 23th, 2024, with the aim of showing to the participants the places of historical memory of the Roma and Sinti people and making them aware of the genocide suffered during the Second World War. The initiative combined visits to places of memory, conferences to promote intercultural dialogue and awareness of the Genocide of the Roma and Sinti during the Second World War with the international rehearsals of the theatrical performance that we will stage on August 2th in Croatia.</p> <p>On November 21th, participants from every country met at the headquarters of the Association "L'isola che c'è". After presenting the program to the participants, the group moved to Isernia, where the participants took possession of the accommodation. The welcome dinner was an opportunity to encourage mutual acquaintance between the participants from different countries.</p> <p>November 22th. The group visited the Convent of San Bernardino (Agnone), a place of internment of 150 Roma and Sinti during the Second World War, with the guidance of Professor Paolo Tanzj, author of the book "Il Porrajmos dei Rom e Sinti". Following, in the council room of the Municipality of Agnone at the presence of the vice Mayor and other local representatives, a conference was held to present the project in which the various representatives of the partner organizations illustrated the objectives and activities planned for citizenship. Back in Isernia, the theater workshop took place with the first international rehearsal of the theatrical performance.</p> <p>On November 23th, the participants returned to Rome where they visited the monument built in memory of the genocide of Roma, Jews and homosexuals at the VII Municipality of the Municipality of Rome. The Memorial Councilor hon Richard Sbordonì, was present at the commemoration ceremony. In the afternoon the participants met at the headquarters of the Association "L'isola che c'è" to discuss the results and collect feedback from the participants.</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • [] The objectives set for this activity have been successfully achieved. The activities carried out have stimulated greater awareness of the Roma and Sinti genocide in the participants and the network has been strengthened among the young people of the partner organizations and between Roma and non-Roma people. The groups have also had the opportunity to confront with the present institutions. It was necessary to intervene with simultaneous translations in the different languages of the participants in order to guarantee active participation by all.
